Rules of Entry:

1. Dressage rules will be as laid down in the 2006 RDA Dressage Rule Book, which can be obtained from Headquarters. **Please read the rule book very carefully so as to avoid confusion and disappointment.**
2. Please note that each horse/pony competing at the Championships who requires stabling WILL NEED A VALID PASSPORT AND ORIGINAL EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION CERTIFICATE.
3. A hat must be worn at all times when mounted and must comply with current RDA Health and Safety guidelines (see section 15, page 11)
4. Helpers should be neatly dressed.
5. Horses and ponies must be five year old or over.
6. Horses/ponies may compete in four tests and be ridden by two riders only (see section 62, page 27)
7. Riders refer to Rule Book.
8. Tests may be ridden from memory or commanded.
